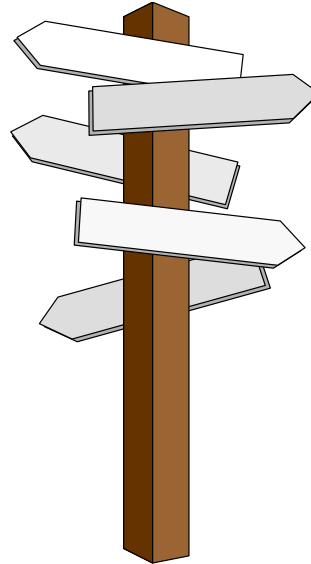
## ***What Courses Are Available ?***

The charge for tuition will be about 90p for each 40-minute period attended.

This can either be paid on a weekly or a termly basis.

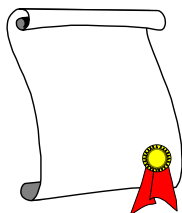
You may be asked to pay a (refundable) deposit for any text books issued to you.

## *Examination Fees*

All exam fees should be paid directly to the school office. At present the fees are approximately £23.75 for Standard Grade and £28.50 for Higher Grade.

(Partial completion of course from around £5.75 per unit).
